

Snazzy Baby Carrier - Follow up review at 10 months old

I first reviewed this baby carrier when my son was about five months old. Now that he is bigger, I've been able to use it more.

The Snazzy Combo Carrier is very versatile. It can be:

- An inward facing side carrier
- An outward facing side carrier
- A pool/ beach carrier (its chlorine and salt water resistant)
- A highchair cover to attach baby more securely than most restaurant buckles
- A portable high chair that you can attach to a regular dining table chair (if baby's at least 6 months old)
- A shopping cart cover (much like the high chair use, you can attach the carrier to a shopping cart and secure little ones MUCH better than those store straps.

As I said before, I particularly like how you can put baby on at the car, walk inside the store, grab a cart and within a few minutes your tot is secured, you never have to take him out of the carrier. When you leave the store, just unsnap a few straps and put him back on. It's almost like using a baby purse.

I still also like how small it is for carting around. You can leave it in your baby bag for whenever. This small size prevents it from being supportive enough for small babies but works fine for babies who can support themselves well sitting on their own.

Something I don't like is that when you have a heavy baby like I do - he was 20 pounds at nine months old- the shoulder strap can get uncomfortable. But with this carrier, that's not that big of a problem because I only wear my son in it to or from a restaurant or store, where I transfer him to a cart or high chair pretty quickly. I just need it to have my two hands free for holding my daughters' hands.
