

Most versatile baby carrier yet: 3-in-1 Snazzy Baby Combo Carrier



The Snazzy Baby [Mom's Deluxe 3 in 1 Plus Combo Carrier](#) should be called the 6 in one combo. This is the most versatile carrier I've come across. It can be:

- An inward facing side carrier
- An outward facing side carrier
- A pool/ beach carrier (its chlorine and salt water resistant)
- A highchair cover to attach baby more securely than most restaurant buckles
- A portable high chair that you can attach to a regular dining table chair (if baby's at least 6 months old)
- A shopping cart cover (much like the high chair use, you can attach the carrier to a shopping cart and secure little ones MUCH better than those store straps.

I particularly like how you can put baby on at the car, walk inside the store, grab a cart and within a minute your tot is secured, you never have to take him out of the carrier. When you leave the store, just unsnap a few straps and put him back on. Very easy!



I also like how small it is. You can leave it in your baby bag for whenever. Another plus - how easy it is to sit and eat with my son on my lap in this carrier. Not very many carriers can claim that. Very nice feature to open up options at restaurants when baby is fussy and will not take sitting in the high chair but still. Gives you hands to eat your food without spilling food on him.

This isn't my favorite all around carrier for my now 5 month old, that honor goes to the [ERGO](#). But this one is even more versatile and it much small for carrying around. This small size prevents it from being supportive enough for small babies. I'll update this review again when my son is 9 months old to see how big babies do in it. The only other thing I don't like

is that the shoulder strap can get uncomfortable with long wear but it has yet to hurt my back. But I do think this is a good one to have in your carrier collection because of all the features it has that no others come close to.
